ANNUAL REPORT- 2018-19

As we share the yearly updates of our activities, we take the modesty to say that we did our best to do as we had planned and we are proud of our students and teachers who strived hard to achieve beyond expectations.

We started our school this year with a proud batch of 176 students. The reopening day for this academic year was 8th June, Friday 2018. The students were welcomed with traditional nadaswaram and melam and the event was with great pomp and show.

To encourage our students to excel in this fiercely competitive world, we lay foundation to emotional resilience to face competitive exams. Students learn best when learning is tailored to their learning style. We teach Math with math manipulatives and Grammar with fun filled activities for effective learning. On the whole, we only focus on the holistic development of all students.

STAFF ENRICHMENT PROGRAM:
